Executive Summary:

World Orphanage Foundation is a non-profit foundation that wants to do philanthropies and donations not only in Afghanistan but all around the world. WOF aims to build 11 water wells in three provinces of Afghanistan. These 11 water wells will benefit all the localities residence with drinking water that do not have access to drinking water.

Survey of the area:

WOF built 11 water wells in 3 provinces of Afghanistan. According to WOF survey conducted on 25th June, 2020, the foundation found that the people living in those areas hardly access to drinking water. And to get water they have to travel a long distance. Out of these 11 water wells 5 are built in Herat, 3 in Kabul and another 3 in Mazar Sharif.

The digging of the 5 water wells started on 13th November, 2020 in 5 different villages of Herat. All the equipment is purchased from that province and carried to the place where the wells were digging. The work continued about 2 weeks continuously. By 26th November the localities had access to drinking water and no more they needed to travel so far to bring water.

After completion digging of 5 water wells in Herat, the work started in Mazar Sharif. according to the survey conducted from Mazar Sharif, three villages were marked as neediest for water and drinking water. Sometimes, the localities do not find water even though they go to the neighboring villages. WOF wants to build the 3 wells in the villages that are neediest. The work started by 20th November, 2020 and completed by 4th December, 2020. By 5th December, all the localities had access to drinking water, and no more they needed to travel so far to get water.

Then the work started for Kabul by digging 3 water wells by 1st December, 2020. These water wells were built in 3 different villages of Kabul and finished its working by 13th December and by 14th December all the localities were able to use from those wells. These villages because of over population had less access to drinking water. That is why WOF built these wells and now everyone has access to the drinking water.



Conclusion:

World Orphanage Foundation built 11 water wells in Kabul, Herat and Mazar Sharif in Afghanistan. The areas that were surveyed were the most vulnerable and neediest for drinking water. Most of the localities had to provide drinking water from far places and villages. With this philanthropy done by WOF, the people can access to water at any time without difficulties.
